

Primus Line in Sinaia - the summer residence of the royal family of Romania!

Sinaia, apart from the fact that it is one of the most beautiful mountain resorts in Romania, is also the locality where at the end of the XIX century, King Carol I - Prince of Hohenzollern - Sigmaringen began the construction of Peles Castle.

The king decided to build this castle, worthy of his status as a German prince in the House of Hohenzollern and as a sign of appreciation for the Romanian people, which also results from his toast - "I built this castle as a lasting sign that the freely chosen dynasty by the nation is deeply rooted in this beautiful country and that we reward the love of our people through the unlimited trust we have in the future of our dear homeland".

In this context, for the first time in Romania the realization of the rehabilitation of a DN 400 steel sewer network in length of 2089 m takes place through the re-lining method, Primus Line pipeline technology.

This kind of project is a premiere for the NO-DIG market in Romania, considering that until now, Primus Line pipeline technology has been used for the rehabilitation of oil networks.
